As parents/carers you can best support your children to secure regular attendance and punctuality by:

- Making sure your child attends school every day, unless there is an exceptional reason preventing this. Please contact school by 9am to report an absence
- Arriving at school on time every day by 8.45am
- Arranging dental and medical appointments outside of school hours where possible
- Informing the school if your child is too unwell to attend by phone or email the office. To assist parents in deciding whether their child is too ill to attend school, the NHS have produced a weblink you mind find useful: <u>Is my child too ill for school</u>? NHS (www.nhs.uk)
- Taking holidays during school holiday periods only
- Attending Parents evenings and school events
- Discussing any problems or difficulties with the school as soon as they arise staff are here to help
