

## English

We will be looking at the text 'The First Drawing' by Mordicai Gerstein. We will focus on the context of our writing and different grammar we can use to make our writing exciting.

- extending the range of sentences with more than one clause by using a wider range of conjunctions
- using preposition phrases
- indicating possession by using the possessive apostrophe
- discussing writing similar to that which we are planning to write in order to understand and learn from its structure, vocabulary and grammar

## History

We will be looking at how people lived in the Stone Age through to the Iron Age.

- Culturally significant places such as Stonehenge and Skara Brae and more locally, Maiden Castle.
- How farming came about and why.
- How these civilisations affected the way we live now and how they impacted upon our environment.

## Art

We will be looking at cave paintings and creating art using paper mediums.

We will be making fossil art using a range of techniques.

## Maths

This half term we are focussing on multiplication and division. The children will be taught to:

- recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables
- write and calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division
- solve problems, including missing number problems, involving multiplication and division
