### Art

Use paint creatively to create "huff and puff" pictures (made by blowing through a straw). Explore materials through printing.

### Phonics

To break ccvc (eg, float) and cvcc (toast) into individual sounds and blend sounds together.

Read and spell exception words.

Read and write sentences using phonic knowledge.

Write simple dictated sentences using sound knowledge.

### Science

Distinguish between an object and what it is made of.

Identify and name a variety of everyday materials (wood, plastic, glass, metal, rock, water, fabric, elastic).

Perform simple tests and describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials.

### Design and Technology

Plan, make and evaluate a puppet.
