Dear Parents,

For our topic of Stone Age to Iron Age, Year 3 this year will be going to the Cranborne Ancient Technology Centre. There will be two expert guides working with us for the day leading activities. The trip will be on the **Wednesday 31st January** and we will be departing from school at 9:00am. We will be arriving back at school at 3.00pm so children can be collected/get buses home as normal.

On the day, children will need to wear non-uniform, this must be old and warm clothes as we will be spending the day outside. It may be cold so you may want to bring hats, scarves and gloves. Please make sure they have a waterproof coat. Children should come to school wearing trainers, and bring a pair of wellies with them in a bag, to change into when we arrive at Cranborne. Please come and see us if this will be a problem. As we will be going for the whole day, children will need a disposable named lunch as well as one named water bottle. If you have ordered a hot meal a packed lunch will be provided instead.

The cost of this trip will be a voluntary contribution of £7.50 per child. FOPS have kindly agreed to subsidise the remaining amount, enabling us to partake in this memorable trip.
